



The Academy is a 54 day skill development program aligned with the long-term athlete development plan facilitated at Lake Louise. Vast and varied, pristine and inspirational, the athletes get to experience a friendly wilderness that's authentically Canadian. Lake Louise is located in the heart of the magnificent Canadian Rockies, with over 4.200 skiable acres of world-class terrain.

The Academy seeks to provide an environment fostering intellectual and physical pursuits through a series of well-rounded programs and the ideal athlete is a strong student looking to become a better all-round skier. The schedule provides two days a week on snow and gives Physical Education high school credits to replace what is normally taken at school.

The 54 days on snow will include the opportunity to take the Avalanche Safety Course (AST) Level 1 which teaches how to recognize avalanche terrain, understand safe travel practices and be taught companion rescue. AST 1 is essential for skiers, snowboarders and snowshoers. The coach of this program is a Level 3 CSIA Certified Instructor, Level 1 CSIA Course Conductor and has race training experience.

PREREQUISITE FOR AST 1: no previous backcountry experience is necessary and you can choose to use snowshoes, backcountry skis or splitboards.

INCLUDES: Canadian Avalanche Association certified instructor, AVCAN AST 1 certificate, course materials, use of transceivers, shovels and probes.

Athletes also get to challenge the Canadian Ski Instructors Alliance (CSIA) Level 1 or Canadian Alliance of Snowboard Instructors (CASI) Level 1. The CSIA Level 1 is the first step to becoming a ski instructor for aged 15 years or older. The three-day Level 1 course is an introduction to ski teaching, CSIA technique and methodology, and the role of ski teaching within the ski industry. It combines the basics of practical ski teaching methods, technical understanding and development of guest service skills, specifically addressing children's skiing.

The Academy athletes ski on Friday and Saturday and will take part in a three-day Christmas Camp and a three-day New Year's camp.

Sundays are left open for students to ski with friends, homestay families or engaging in other amazing mountain resort town activities.

BANFF

OUR PROGRAM

- Canadian Rockies Public Schools (CRPS) has an excellent reputation for educational programming and ranks amongst the top performing school divisions in Alberta.
- International students receive an individualized academic program following the Alberta curriculum enabling them to achieve Alberta Education credits which can lead to a high school diploma and university entrance. Study for 5 months, 1 school year, or multiple years if you wish to earn your high school diploma.
- All students receive high quality instruction from certified Alberta teachers, fostering students to achieve their maximum potential.
- International students have the advantage of graduating from a leading Canadian school system while gaining fluency in English, a skill that has practical utilization worldwide.

CURRICULUM

- Functional competency in English is required to join our academic program. Course placement decisions will be based on the student's English proficiency. Emphasis will be placed on developing the language skills necessary to succeed in core subject areas.
- Core Subjects: Mathematics, English, Social Studies, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Science, Physical Education.
- Students use state-of-the-art technology to enhance learning including modern computer labs and fully equipped workshops. We have WiFi throughout our schools and students are encouraged to use their devices in our classrooms and study areas.
- Our ESL course is designed for students who wish to improve their English language skills in a friendly, yet challenging atmosphere. Reading, writing, listening and speaking are emphasized as students are introduced to the rules of the English language.
