



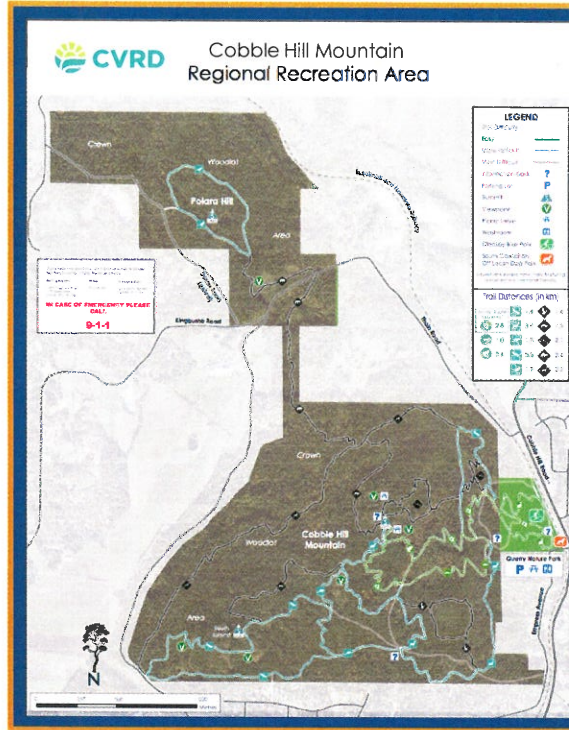
FIELDWORK

Students work in groups of 5-7 people planning, surveying and then building a new section of trail within the forest to standards set by CVRD Parks and IMBA (International Mountain Biking Association.) Teacher support is provided during fieldwork but groups are able and expected to work independently.

Students will learn which tools work most appropriately and more importantly, how to properly and safely use these tools in the field.

POLARA HILL AT COBBLE HILL MOUNTAIN RECREATION AREA

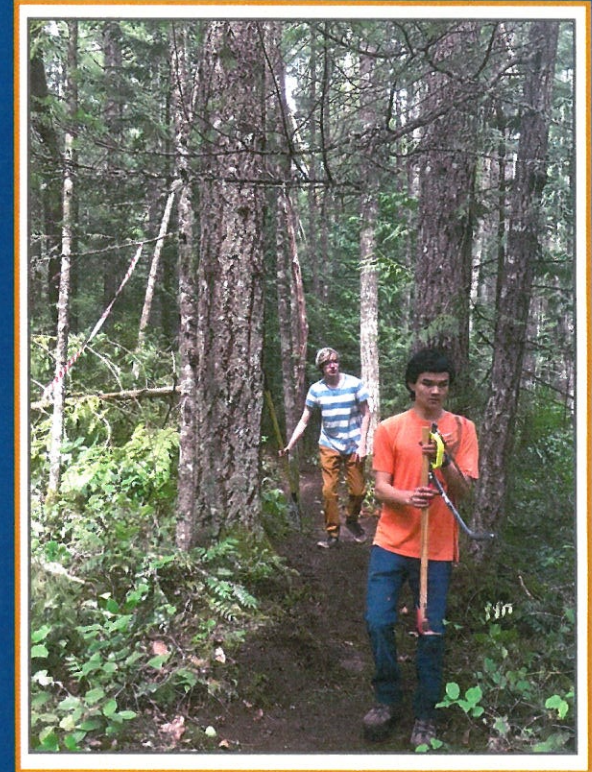
Students in the Trails and Streams program build and maintain trails in the nearby recreation area of Polara Hill. Polara Hill, located ten kilometers from FKSS, is designated an interpretive forest where selective tree harvesting and public recreation use takes place through a partnership between CVRD Parks and the designated woodlot licensee.

Recreational users include hikers, mountain bikers and horse riders.
